#### 5 Reasons to Meditate

You might say that your life is too busy to meditate! Being still is a waste of time, there's work to be done! Maybe you tried to meditate but couldn't do it. Consider these thoughts:

- 1. "Be Still and Know God" says that being still might be the way to know God.
- 2. Meditating is choosing something to focus on intentionally instead of letting the world jerk your attention around with shiny things and advertisements.
- 3. To meditate is to clear your mind, to let it settle. Like mud in water, when it gets still, it gets clearer.
- 4. Meditating while being still is good for your nervous system. It retrains your mind from being reactive to being calm and peaceful.
- 5. To meditate is to just be still for awhile. When you are still it can calm the mind and rest the body.

# The Music Ministry Tammy Gibson, Interim Music Director

## From the Pastor . . .

I have commandeered the Music column this month to share with you some really good news.

First, I know we are all grateful to have had Tammy Gibson with us since the first of February. She has been a great blessing to just step right in and guide through the first few months of this transition. Fortunately for her (and unfortunately for us!) she is retiring from JCPS at the end of the school year. She wants to REALLY retire so she is leaving us, too, after the Memorial Day Weekend service. Tammy has been just what we needed and I am beyond grateful for her. Please join me in wishing her "Happy Retirement" and a hearty "Thank You" from First Baptist.

Knowing Tammy's retirement was coming, your personnel committee has been working many hours on securing our next Interim Director of Music and Worship. We are happy to announce we have hired Mrs. Julie Halitzka to fill this very important role. Julie heard about us through Susan Bowles, her work colleague, and sent us a resume some months ago.

Julie is a native of New Jersey, but she ended up in Iowa at Cornell College, where she majored in music and minored in psychology. From there, she landed at Parkview Church in Iowa City, a very large multicampus church near the University of Iowa. She was responsible for the Thursday night college worship service and worked with many volunteers and staff members. There she met her husband, George, who was also on the staff. Julie started an online Master of Divinity in Worship from The Southern Baptist Theological Seminary and eventually, she and George moved to Louisville to complete the degree in-person at the seminary. She graduated in May, 2011.

For the past twelve years, Julie was on the music staff of St. John United Methodist Church in Prospect. She led the contemporary worship services, the handbell choir, sang in the Sanctuary Choir, and did much of the technical work related to worship. The church downsized their staff in January of this year, just about the time Susan told her of Leslie's imminent retirement.

While in Louisville, Julie did a lot of work in early childhood education, and completed a Master of Science degree in Early Childhood Studies, Administration, Management, and Leadership. She works full-time for the University of Kentucky Child Care Aware program where she helps families and centers in quality improvement.

Julie has been hired for an average of seventeen hours per week and her responsibilities will include all worship services, coordination of all ensembles, working with the youth and children in music programs, and choir rehearsal.


